


















Spotlight: Parenting Wisely





Parenting Wisely is a highly interactive, online evidence-based parenting program.

Participants learn new skills by viewing a variety of common and challenging home scenarios, discussing options, and practicing new strategies. Scientists have shown that this program:

- Reduces youth substances abuse
- Reduces school and homework problems
- Reduces juvenile delinquency
- Reduces family conflict and child abuse
- Increases participation in future parenting programs

Household scenarios like being interrupted on the telephone, challenging bedtimes, getting ready for school, sibling and classmate conflict, and more teach these skills:

- Active Listening
- Family Meetings

- Assertive Discipline
- Behavior Contracting
- Setting Boundaries
