## Call to Order

September meeting of the Monroe Community Coalition was called to order at 1PM by Tom MacIntyre. The September agenda focused on Community Prevention and Wellness Initiative orientation and discussion around launching a series of parent-focused community trainings.

## Community Spotlight 1: Parent HUB

Kathy Bernhardt and Kathy Jackson, Family Liaisons from Monroe School District, talked about their efforts to increase family involvement in school. The Family Liaisons explained their role in building relationships and collaboration between families, schools and the community.

## Community Spotlight 2: Transportation – Legacy – Community (TLC)

Bill Mahoskey and Lisa Golden shared about their growing collaboration of drivers in the school district's transportation department. TLC members have embraced the role of becoming trusted adults, using their positions and talents to build supportive relationships and serving as a bridge to helping adults at school. TLC is working with other community groups, including Monroe Community Coalition and the Monroe Public Schools foundation to ensure their students are well supported.

## CPWI Orientation

Joe Neigel walked the coalition through our history, accomplishments and the requirements expected of statewide Community Prevention and Wellness Initiative sites. ## Parent Talk Series Launches

The Coalition Leadership Team proposed continuing last year's parent outreach events, doing more of them, and developing a brand for the series. Discussion included finding a neutral facility, such as Sno-Isle Libraries, to bring in as many participants as possible (recognizing that many parents do not attend meetings that occur at schools their students do not attend). The group brainstormed a series of offerings for the Coalition to consider, including:

- Youth Mental Health/Trusted Adult training
- o Youth Mental Health First Aid

- o Restorative Practices
- o Equipping parents to teach anti-bullying skills at home (using the Power Up! Curriculum)
- Continuing tech talk
- o A parent compliment to the middle school personal safety unit
- o Crossover events with Housing Hope's College of Hope offerings
- o Town Halls on underage drinking, marijuana and vape use
- Strengths-based Parenting

Coalition members explored a variety of brands, but were most excited about "Parent Talk."

The first of this year's Parent Talk offerings will occur on Tuesday, October 17 from 6:30-8:00pm featuring Erin Wood discussing youth mental health and becoming a trusted adult.
